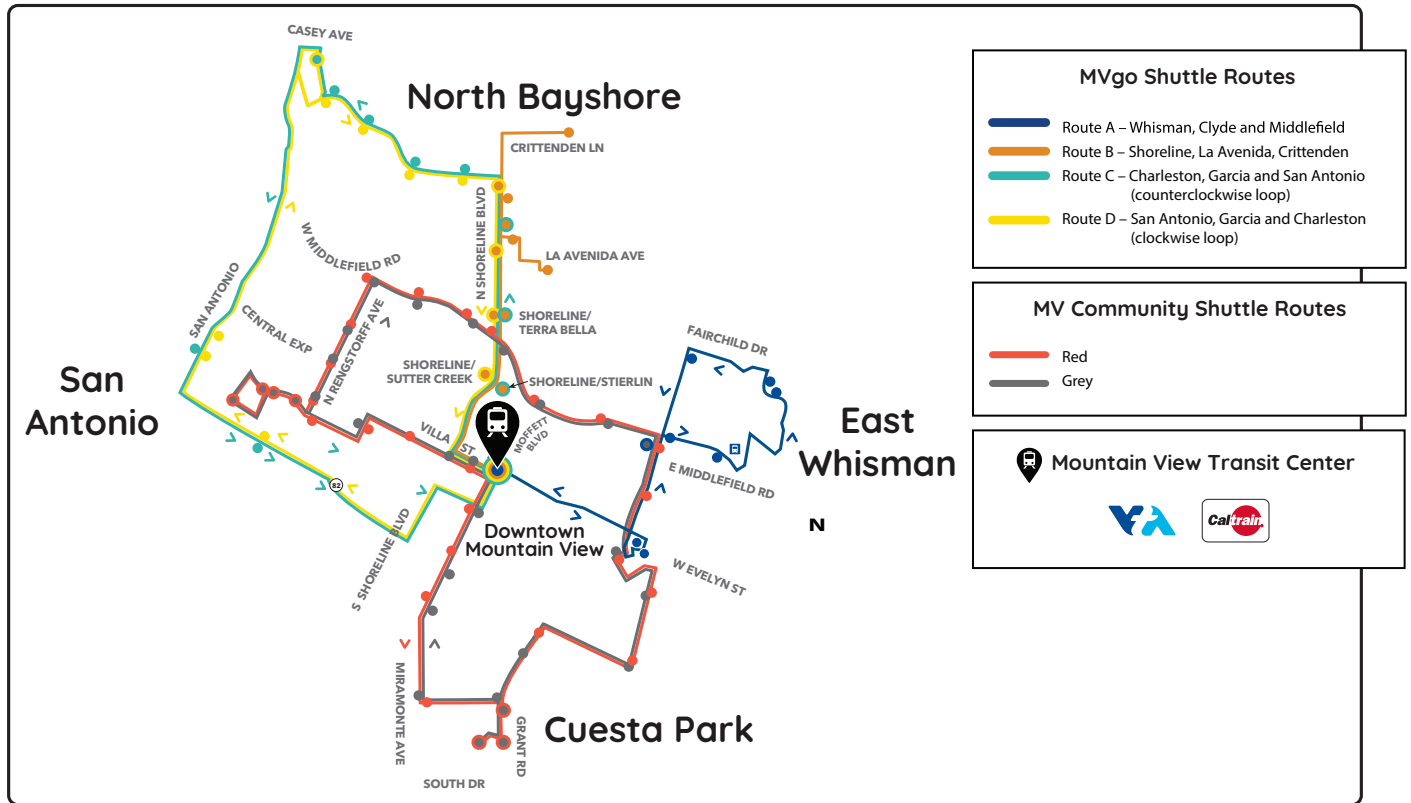

# About Us:

MVgo services are provided by the Mountain View Transportation Management Association, an organization dedicated to reducing traffic congestion by providing free or low-cost transportation alternatives that make commuting convenient for employees, residents, and visitors in Mountain View.

The Mountain View Transportation Management Association also partners with the City of Mountain View to provide the Mountain View Community Shuttle.



## Shuttles

There are two shuttle systems available, providing residents and commuters with a cohesive transit network that is fare-free and open to the public.

The **MVgo Shuttle** provides connectivity to and from the Mountain View Transit Center during the commute period.

The **Mountain View Community Shuttle** runs 7 days a week with service hours of 7AM to 7PM on weekdays and 10AM to 6PM on weekends, providing transit connectivity to downtown Mountain View, schools, the library, parks, shopping centers, and the El Camino Hospital.

## Live Tracking

To get estimated arrival times or view the location of your shuttle, download the TripShot app and select "Public System" then "**MVgo**" or "**MV Community Shuttle**" or use the **TripShot website**.

## MVgo SmartCommute Tool

## MVgo Guaranteed Last Mile

The Mountain View Transportation Management Association will **reimburse you up to \$15** for your trip to or from the Mountain View or San Antonio Caltrain Station, should an MVgo Shuttle arrive more than 15 minutes late, or Caltrain is delayed.
