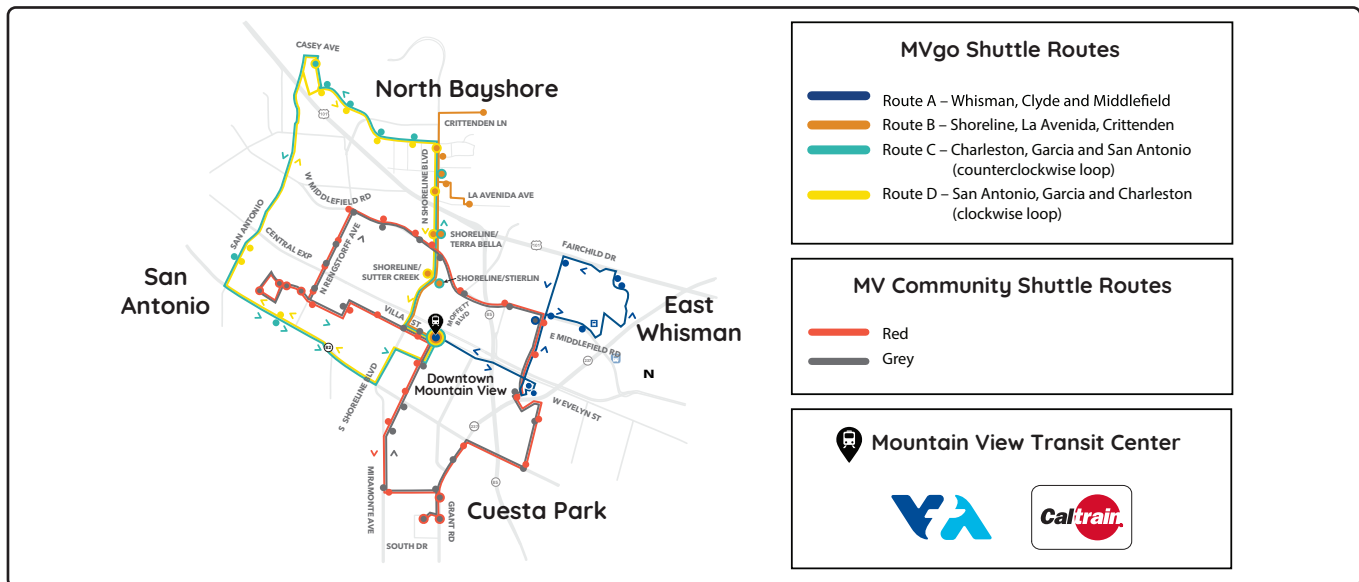


ARE YOU TIRED OF TRAFFIC?

As traffic and gas prices rise across the Bay Area and Mountain View, the Mountain View Transportation Management Association, in partnership with the City of Mountain View, encourages you to help reduce congestion and greenhouse gas emissions by choosing alternative transportation.

The Mountain View community is served by two shuttle systems, providing residents and commuters with a cohesive transit network that is fare-free and open to the public.



The MVgo shuttle operates during the commute period providing access to downtown, Mountain View Transit Center, San Antonio Center, and large employment centers in the North Bayshore and East Whisman areas.

The Mountain View Community Shuttle runs 7 days a week with service hours of 7AM to 7PM on weekdays and 10AM to 6PM on weekends, providing transit connectivity to downtown Mountain View, schools, the library, parks, shopping centers, and the El Camino Hospital.

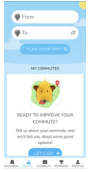
The service is fare-free and open to the public.

VTA Light Rail & Bus Service

Mountain View is served by VTA's light rail and bus service. Use VTA's Orange Line from the Mountain View Transit Center and Middlefield stations to get to various places in Santa Clara, Milpitas and San Jose, such as Levi Stadium, Great America, the Great Mall, or connect with BART and ACE Train. VTA also has various bus routes connecting residents and commuters of Mountain View to various locations in Santa Clara County, including Foothill College, Stanford University, Santa Clara University, the SAP Center, and San Jose State University. Guaranteed Last Mile Program
